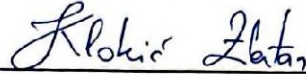

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Proposal from RRB STRATEGIES LLC.

We are pleased to submit a proposal for public and government affairs representation to the Republic of Srpska. The historic election of President Donald J. Trump presents an opportunity to forge a strong bilateral relationship built upon issues of mutual interest.

As you will see in this proposal, we have strong and unique relationships within the new Trump Administration, which could be utilized to improve the relationship between our countries very effectively.

Governor Rod Blagojevich will serve in the senior advisory role for the campaign. 3. Diplomatic Initiatives:

- Campaign for the removal of the illegally appointed High Representative not confirmed by the UN Security Council
- Seek the lifting of sanctions imposed on Srpska officials.
- Work to ensure the return of all competencies to Srpska as guaranteed by the Dayton Accords.

4. Cultural and Religious Advocacy:

- Promote policies that safeguard the rights and freedoms of Christians in Bosnia and Herzegovina, ensuring they are free from pressure by Bosnian Muslims and supportive globalist entities.

5. Military and Institutional Strategies:

- Lobbying to ensure that NATO forces do not exceed the limits of their powers and jurisdiction;
- Advocate for removing the Office of the High Representative (OHR) from Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Goals

Short-term (3-month timeframe):

- Establish and maintain intensive and personal contacts with highly positioned decision-makers within the State Department;
- Work to minimize or end the negative campaign against President Dodik and all officials and institutions of the Republic of Srpska;

Mid-term (6-month timeframe):

- Work to accomplish recognition of President Dodik and all officials and institutions of the Republic of Srpska as true defenders of the Dayton Peace Agreement and both the Constitution of BiH and RS, respectively;
- Lobby the US State Department to demand that Bosnian Muslims recognize President Dodik and institutions of the Republic of Srpska as true and legitimate partners in all processes in BiH

- Work to ensure the return of all competencies to Srpska as guaranteed by the Dayton Accords.

Long-term (12-month timeframe):

- Work to abolish and null-and-void sanctions against President Dodik, his family members, and other RS representatives and officials;
- Work to Self-determination for the people of the Republic of Srpska and ultimate elimination of the unelected position of the OHR.
- Work to encourage legal procedure against German diplomat Christian Schmidt for illegally occupying the position of the High Representative in BiH.

Dynamics of reporting:

- Reports are expected to be provided every week. Their content is to be analytical, informed, and gathered through personal contacts to positively position the Republic of Srpska in the USA.

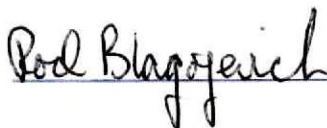
Budget
